Fort Lauderdale, FL - Sunshine and fun await. Fort Lauderdale is a city on Florida's southeastern coast, known for its beaches and boating canals. The Strip is a promenade running along oceanside highway A1A. It's lined with upscale outdoor restaurants, bars, boutiques and luxury hotels.

Cartagena, Colombia - Following two days at sea visit Cartagena, once a bastion of the Spanish Main and boasting colonial architecture and the finest emeralds in the world. Spain poured millions into the port's defense, building the fortifications that are today a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You can walk those deeply textured alleyways today through some of the best-preserved colonial



neighborhoods of the Americas. When you're ready for a change, there are beaches ready. Bocagrande is busy and close to the city. Playa Blanca is south across the bay and quieter.



Panama Canal - Marvel as your ship is lifted 85 feet from the Caribbean to Gatún Lake then gently lowered to the Pacific, using no power other than the force of gravity. Truly one of life's great travel thrills.

Puerto Caldera (Puntarenas), Costa Rica - Delight as brilliant blue morpho butterflies flit about you in the rain forest; visit Poas Volcano before it blows again. It's hard to throw a stick in Costa Rica and not have it hit a national

park. The city Puerto Caldera, an Costa Rica's Pacific coast, has a number of them within easy reach for cruise visitors. Just to the south, Carara is a mecca for birders, especially those chasing the scarlet macaw. Poas Volcano is inland, and rises to nearly 9,000 feet. See it before it blows again. Barra Honda contains a series of limestone caves. Palo Verde preserves one of the last tropical dry rainforests in Central America. Arenal has the most active volcano in the country. Tapanti contains species of orchids discovered only in 2009.



Corinto, Nicaragua - Nicaragua, Central America's new travel phenomenon. Banana plantations, Mayan ruins, colonial León are all here. So is the world-famous Flor de Caña rum distillery. Nicaragua has been billed as the next great spot for eco-cultural and culinary tourism. Corinto offers the chars of the larger cities, including their colonialera architecture, as well as a number of cultural and ecological attractions in surrounding areas.



Puerto Quetzal, Guatemala - Modernity meets Maya in Puerto Quetzal, where weavers spin their brilliantly colored stories on backstrap looms while the harbor handles Panamax-sized cargo vessels. This is the largest port on the Pacific Ocean side of this Central American country, important for both cargo and cruise ships. Puerto Quentzal is an ideal point of departure for exploring Guatemala's stunning, volcano-studded landscape, or one of the country's Maya sites, the UNESCO-recognized colonial city of Antigua, or a coffee plantation.

Huatulco, Mexico - Situated on Mexico's Pacific Coast in the state of Oaxaca, has nine bays and 36 beaches, offering more than enough opportunities for fun in the sun. There are also archaeological sites to explore, rivers to raft, and waterfalls. Bird lovers, will find Huatulco to be especially captivating, as it is home to more than 225 species, including many rare ones and a number that are endemic to Mexico, like the Colima pygmy owl.

Puerto Vallarta- squeezed into the thin space between Banderas Bay and the verdant folds of the Sierra Madre. It still retains the essence of the fishing village it once was. Viejo Vallarta, the old town, is a mix of red-tiled buildings, cobbled streets, chic shops and busy open markets. Other highlights include Mismaloya Beach, Gringo Gulch, and Conchas Chinas, the Beverly Hills of Vallarto.
