# Alaska, Double Denali & Glacier Bay Cruise Cruisetour #D3L

You will see the many faces of Alaska-by cruise ship

through the Inside Passage - motorcoach through the interior of Alaska -and by rail, viewing much of the hidden scenery. You will experience all of this on your journey to Alaska.

Journey to the great state of Alaska as you fly to Fairbanks. You will transfer to your downtown hotel and enjoy your first night's stay in this former gold rush boomtown.

A full-day adventure with **lunch included**. Step aboard the **sternwheeler Discovery** and cruise the Chena and Tanana Rivers. Lunch will be included today. Soak up native culture, gold rush history, and local color as you visit a replicated Athabascan native

village and view native crafts, see dog sled **demonstrations**, as well as salmon fishing wheels. At Gold Dredge No. 8, a



National Historic Site, you'll browse the mining exhibits, pan for gold. Keep whatever you find in your pan at the mining sluice.

Today it is off to Denali National Park, where you check into your comfortable room at **Denali Lodge** for your **two night** stay, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Some optional activities include a helicopter ride, river rafting, horseback tours, ATV adventure or nine holes of golf. For dinner choose from river-



view eateries to the rustic family-style barbeque and musical at the Cabin Nite Dinner Theatre- a popular favorite.

An early morning departure on the Denali Park **Tundra Wilderness Tour**, with a sack snack. The tour is **narrated** by a driver-guide and travels to mile 53 of the park road and offers opportunities to view wildlife which may include Caribou, Dall sheep, Moose, Grizzly Bear and wolves. Weather permitting, fabulous views of Mt. McKinley

will be unsurpassed. Be sure to have plenty of film with you. The rest of the day is free to craft your own wilderness experience.



Wake up to a morning at leisure then board the McKinley Explorer, the largest domed railcar on the historic Alaska Railroad route, an Alaska Scenic Byway. Sit back and relax in the observation lounge and watch magnificent scenery glide by, hoping to get a look at Mt. McKinley, the highest peak in North America. Optional lunch is available to enhance your sightseeing experience. Soak in the magnificent views as you cross the Hurricane Gulch Bridge and glide from one mountain, forest and river scene after another. Here you'll enjoy an overnight stay with mountain views in every direction. You will overnight in Anchorage.

Today enjoy a scenic motorcoach tour as you journey along Turnagain Arm and Ocross through the Chugach and Kenai

Mountains on your way to Resurrection Bay and the port town of **Seward**, where you will overnight. You will have time to



explore the shops and sea aquarium.

Consider adding a spectacular Kenai Fjords National Park excursion before you board the ms Noordam. While on board the ship all of your meals and entertainment will be included.

Enjoy a leisurely day of cruising. In many parts, it's just you, the water, the glaciers and the wildlife. The cruise ship has a variety of activities to keep you busy or you can spend your time on deck enjoying the scenery as you cruise. Keep your eyes open for Whales, as it is not unusual to see them swimming in this area.

Glacier Bay National Park has been an irresistible cruise attraction ever since the 1880's. Cruise the ice-studded fjords of this national treasure for a full eight hours as a Park Ranger narrates. Glacier Bay, encompassing

more than 25 million acres, this World Heritage Site has more active tidewater glaciers than anywhere on Earth. You are at the face of



Margerie Glacier, close enough to hear the glacier groaning and to feel the drifting spray made as a tower of ice the size of a three-story building breaks off and thunders into the sea. When an iceberg is born, the sound is like thunder. You relish every moment, marveling at the sights and sounds of calving glaciers. The impact shoots water hundreds of feet into the air and waves lap gently against your ship.


**Haines** Nestled on the shores of America's longest fjord, Haines is in J a spectacular setting. Fill your day with a float trip through the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve which protects the habitat of the nation's avian symbol, or visit the Sheldon

Museum, art galleries and local hops in town. Optional highspeed catamaran access for shopping and excursions in Skagway will also be available.

In **Juneau**, the state capital, you will have the opportunity to participate in ▲ many exciting things; try a salmon bake - cooked over an alder wood fire, sport fishing, a whale watch excursion, pan for gold, visit the Mendenhall Glacier or try a flight seeing excursion to give you an eagle eye view of the vast Juneau Icefields and Mt. McKinley. The day is yours to explore as you are here all day.

Today your ship calls at **Ketchikan**, a uniquely Alaskan port, famous for its rich native culture, Salmon fishing, and scenic Misty Fjords. Go ashore and explore or shop for souvenirs unique to southeast Alaska. Maybe you want to try your luck at catching an Alaska Salmon.

You are homeward bound today, as you cruise the Inside Passage, relax and enjoy the comforts this great cruise ship has to offer. They are designed with lots of open sunlit spaces,



wide teak decks and activities to please everyone.
