Day 5: Sunday, September 18, 2022 Heraklion (Crete)** - Santorini Enjoy an excursion to the incredible open-air museum of the Minoan Palace of Knossos. Then, during free time in Crete's largest city, enjoy a variety of museums, shopping, or visit a nearby winery to sample traditional Greek wine. Later, arrive on the fabled island of Santorini, known as the "Black Pearl of the Aegean." Enjoy time at leisure to independently explore this lovely port or purchase a ship excursion from the cruise line. (*B*, *L*, *D*)

Day 7: Tuesday, September 20, 2022 Thessaloniki - Kavala - Philippi - Thessaloniki Travel to the coastal town of Kavala where Paul, accompanied by Silas, Luke and Timothy, first set foot on European soil. In nearby Philippi, Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, planting the seeds of Christianity. Join a local expert for a guided tour of this historic town featuring the archaeological site and monuments spanning the Ancient Roman and Byzantine eras. See the dungeon where Paul was

Day 8: Wednesday, September 21, 2022 Thessaloniki - Meteora - Kalambaka Proceed through the fertile Thessalian Valley to Meteora (UNESCO). These dark, sandstone pinnacles rise abruptly from the plain of Thessaly, with 6 historic monasteries perched upon their peaks. Beginning in the 10th century, hermits, monks, and ascetics sought solitude and spiritual solace in these dramatic crags. Visit two amazing Meteora monasteries*** which are renowned for their intricate construction and exquisite Byzantine art. Overnight in Kalambaka. (*B*, *D*)

Day 9: Thursday, September 22, 2022 Kalambaka - Athens Travel through the plains of Central Greece to Athens, arriving in the early afternoon. In Athens, see the hill of Areopagus (Mars Hill) – where Paul delivered his famous "Men of Athens" speech – and visit the incomparable Acropolis before

settling in to your hotel for a 2-night stay. The evening is yours to explore Greece's vibrant capital city. (B)

Day 10: Friday, September 23, 2022 Athens - Corinth - Athens Travel to Corinth where Paul lived and preached for two years and also wrote 2 epistles. Next, make your way to the Church of All Nations, built over the rock on which Jesus is believed to have prayed in agony the night before He was crucified. Take a moment to reflect among the olive trees of the Garden of Gethsemane – the site of Christ's betrayal by Judas. Travel to Mount Zion and the nearby Upper Room, considered the traditional site of the Last Supper. Your day concludes with a visit to the Garden Tomb, the possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and the resurrection of Jesus. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Old City - Western Wall - Kotel Tunnel - Via Dolorosa - Holy Sepulchre

Walk in the footsteps of millions before you as you traverse the Old City. Your visit begins at the Western Wall of the Temple, Judaism's holiest site. Visit the Kotel Tunnel** which is the underground continuation of the Wailing Wall. This portion of the Wall is 8 times longer than the open-air section, providing you with the first-hand perception of the grandiose proportions of the Second Temple. Then, pause at the Church of St. Anne and the nearby Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the paralytic. Pass by the Ecce Homo Arch (Behold the Man), where tradition holds that Pontius Pilate presented Our Lord to the crowds. Travel the Way of the Cross – the Via Dolorosa – walked by Our Lord on the way to His crucifixion. Visit the church of the Holy Sepulchre, the possible site of His crucifixion, burial and resurrection. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure in Jerusalem. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 6: Jerusalem - Athens, Greece

This morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Athens, Greece. Today breakfast will be included.

During a guided tour, meander along towering marble columns and admire the *Pietà*, Michelangelo's renowned sculpture. Pause for a moment of reflection by the *Confessio*, the sunken area directly in front of the tomb of the Apostle and which is dedicated to the Confession of faith by Peter that led to his martyrdom. Then, visit the Mamertine Prison, where Paul was arrested, bound in chains and executed. Take time to reflect before an evening at leisure. Perhaps you will join an optional dinner in a popular restaurant, where you'll indulge in a hearty meal accompanied by wine and local entertainment. *Today breakfast will be included*.

Day 13: Rome - Catacombs - Optional Excursion

Begin your day exploring one of Rome's sixty Catacombs. It was in these underground tunnels that early Christians hid and buried their dead. The afternoon is yours to explore more of the Eternal City. Consider an optional tour to the Vatican Museums,** taking in world-renowned wonders such as the Sistine Chapel and Michelangelo's mural of the Last Judgment. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 14: Rome - Depart for Home

**The optional tour to the Vatican Museums may operate on a different day on select departures due to availability of reservations and closure on Sundays and holidays. Dates and times are subject to change based on availability of reservations.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

A minimum of 4 passengers is required for this extension to operate.

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (1-2 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, Zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. You can expect some longer days balanced with free-time to recharge or set out on your own adventure.
