Explore the spectacular sights and sounds, as well as the glacier-clad shores of South central Alaska. **Glacier Bay National Park**, the crown jewel of the inside passage has been an irresistible attraction since the 1880's. Then watch with camera and binoculars in hand for a chance to spot wildlife and view the beautiful scenery this state has to offer. The ports you visit will be **Haines** with optional access to **Skagway**, a Klondike Gold Rush National Historical Park, **Juneau** with a chance to get off and explore the State's Capital, and the village of **Ketchikan**, famous for its Totem Poles. This is what you came to Alaska to see, but it's only part of the adventure. You arrive at the port of Vancouver where you will transfer for your return flight home.

Seward Transfer between Anchorage and your ship in Seward, on one of the most beautiful stretches of highway in America as you follow the Seward Highway, taking in views of the lofty Chugach Mountains and the dramatic shoreline of Turnagain Arm. One of Southcentral Alaska's oldest communities, Seward is ground zero for the Klondike Gold Rush's Iditarod National Historic Trail. This mellow town welcomes visitors to Resurrection Bay and Kenai Fjords National Park In town, favorite stops remain the Alaska SeaLife Center, a research aquarium open to the public



Glacier Bay National Park has been an irresistible cruise attraction ever since the 1880's. Here the glories of monumental glaciers are close at hand. Magnificent in repose, they thrill the spectator with thundering cataclysms as towering pinnacles of electric-blue ice tumble into the sea. When an iceberg is born, the sound is like thunder. The impact shoots water hundreds of feet into the air and waves lap gently against your ship. You relish every moment, marveling as the sights and sounds of calving glaciers.

Haines Nestled on the shores of America's longest fjord, Haines is in a spectacular setting. Fill your day with a float trip through the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve which protects the habitat of the nation's avian symbol, or visit the Sheldon Museum, art galleries and local hops in town. Optional highspeed catamaran access for shopping and excursions in **Skagway** will also be available. Skagway, this Klondike Gold Rush town boasts restored buildings, wooden boardwalks and the famed White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad,

Juneau, the state capital, you will have the opportunity to participate in many exciting things; try a salmon bake - cooked over an alder wood fire, a whale watch excursion, pan for gold, visit the Mendenhall Glacier or try a flight seeing excursion to give you an eagle eye view of the vast Juneau Icefields and Mt. McKinley. The day is yours to explore as you are here all day.



Ketchikan, explore this quaint city, the ship will be here until 8:00 this evening. In this Tlingit Indian culture you can view the world's largest collection of totem poles, sport fishing is also wonderful here. Explore the shops - here you will find everything from locally canned salmon to Russian nesting dolls.
